The Vinylpostcards App offers you a variety of possibilities to digitally integrate further information in the form of text, audio tracks, images or even videos in addition to the content transported on the physical card. This form will guide you step by step through all individual items that are displayed in the App. Please insert the information according to the explanations and provide us with the required data on the server folder provided (App-Data). In order to use the form functions to the full extent, please use Adobe Acrobat Reader. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.

1. Song title & release metadata

In addition to the track, that will be pressed onto the physical card, you have the option of adding two additional tracks to the app. In contrast to the song on the physical card, the tracks that can be added to the app are limited to a playing time of 10 minutes. Please enter both the title that is on the card and the titles that you would like to add in the form. Like the vinyl master, the digital masters for the app must be delivered as **.wav files in 24Bit / 44.1kHz**. Please note that you can supply a dedicated digital master of the track that will be pressed onto the card. As a result, you can also include a longer version of this title in the app. Please place all digital masters in the corresponding folder (App-Data).
